SUBJECT

Requirements for road transportation.

CATEGORY

Advisory.

APPLICABILITY

All Ultramagic burner frames assembled using nylon rods and subject to road transportation out of the requirements of the Flight Manual - Section 7.4.

COMPIANCE

Achieve at pre-flight inspection.

BACKGROUND

It has been found that incorrect road transportation of the burner frame rigged to the basket can contribute to an abnormal degradation of its condition, sometimes worsened by inappropriate strapping. This service instruction is a reminder to complete the applicable Pre-flight Checklist as required.

INSTRUCTIONS

Burners should be de-rigged for road transportation (see FM section 7.4). If on a given occasion it is necessary to transport the basket with the burner assembled, then great care should be taken to ensure that no damage is made to the basket and burner frame.

This service instruction is a reminder to complete the applicable Pre-flight Checklist, as required. If cracks or damages to the frames are found, Ultramagic S.A must be advised.

In doubt contact your Ultramagic dealer or the factory.
